Canberra Kart Racing Club Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

Attendees: Bob Harnas (P), Brian Gahan (S), Karla House (ML), Paul McCabe (RD)

Apologies: Robin Mules (FO), Tahn Eather (VP)

Meeting opened at 1905.

The previous meeting minutes were from the February Committee Meeting (20260303_CM_Minutes). These have already been accepted and published.

P – Opened the meeting and thanked attendees for their ongoing engagement and assistance with the running of the club.

The focus of this meeting was to wrap up the ACT Titles and prepare for the CKRC Round 1 meet in April (noting the P may be away for a couple of weeks). Specifically:

P – Arrange a sponsor sign for O'Neil and Brown Fire and ensure they are added to the website and plugged on Facebook. A number of fire extinguishers had reached their expiration and these were replaced free of charge by O'Neil and Brown.

S – Had been in contact with Jax Mitchell regarding the disposal of karting tyres. S to continue the dialogue. Jax were to contact their tyre disposal company (TyreCycle) and see what the best price they could do for us per tyre. He would then contact S to discuss further. Potential here for them, as sponsor, to cover the cost in exchange for signage and advertising, or an arrangement with members.

S – We need to order a replacement plate for the TAG Light trophy (ACT Titles). The trophy blew over and was damaged. We would re-purpose one of the un-used ones to replace. The winner was Shannon Mortlock – S to contact and arrange.

S – There were three cancellations received after entry closure for ACT Titles. These were Sher, Schmidt and Ford. Given the reason (or lack of reason provided), FO to refund Ford fully (\$250), and Sher and Schmidt partially (\$150). There was a subsequent enquiry from Stabile about a refund. This was also received after entries closed. They would receive a partial refund too.

P – Contact the MX club and thank them for the use of their facilities for parking.

P – Would arrange trophies (9 sets) for Round 1.

P – Would arrange accommodation for officials for Round 1.

S and RD to complete the Supp Regs for Round 1 and submit to KNSW ASAP.

P – Advised that we would offer an early bird special (\$100) for the first week of entries, before returning to the usual pricing.

P – Meet Track Maintenance in person to pass on the committee's appreciation and make sure any concerns are addressed.

P and RD – Investigate and potentially purchase some weights (plates/kettlebells/etc) to use as test weights for the scales.

RD advised that the stewards room roller door needs some attention. P advised that he'll see what Track Maintenance can do, but doesn't want to spend money on it, as the entire building is due to be demolished as part of the track remediation works.

RD to provide a list of officials and volunteers to P so they can be paid.

P Advised that Tayla was busy rustling up potential sponsors for the 2026 championship season, looking for cash prizes for the top three class winners overall. More information would be available as she works through it.
